

John Thyberg arrived here Saturday and is now at Jess Willey's, where he worked before entering the army. John saw some hard service while in France, having gone to the front within two months after reaching there. He did not receive a scratch although holes were cut in his clothes by bullets. He was "over the top" four times and at one time while doing outpost duty with a company of two hundred, they were within 100 feet of a machine gun nest which they kept inactive by rifle fire until the remainder of the army could get in position. John was also in a bayonet fight where each one's life was simply a question of being the better man.
