

Passed Away Tuesday Morning

DEATH ROBS THIS COMMUNITY OF
ONE OF ITS WELL KNOWN
WOMEN

Mrs. Will Angel, after an illness lasting but two weeks, passed away at 2:30 Tuesday morning at their residence in the western part of town, the cause of her death being Brights disease. Up to a few weeks ago she seemed in perfect health, and her friends but little realized that she was seriously ill.

Although all hopes of her recovery had been abandoned several days ago, her death proved a shock to her numerous friends. She was well known here, having been born and raised just a few miles north of Wimbleton, where her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Effelson, were old time farmers in that community.

Mrs. Angel was well liked and highly spoken of by all who knew her, being of a cheerful disposition and always willing to lend aid wherever she could. She was a dutiful wife and kind mother, being much devoted to her home.

She leaves besides her husband, two small children, a boy aged three years 6 months, and a boy born but three weeks ago.

Services were held at the house at 10 o'clock this morning, conducted by Rev. Stevenson and the remains taken to the Lutheran church northeast of Courtenay, where services were also conducted, after which the remains were laid to rest in the cemetery nearby, close to those of her father.
