

## Death Takes Mother

Word was received here Tuesday of the death of Mrs. Agnes Klemik, at her home in Independence, Wis., which occurred during the afternoon. Mrs. Klemik was the mother of Andrew and John Klemik and Mrs. John Spisla, all of this city.

She was well along in years, being 84 years of age at the time of death. She was not known to be ill and the announcement of her death came as a great shock to her children here. Cause of death is not known, but presumably it was caused mostly by old age.
