GRIM REAPER ROBS LARGE FAMILY OF FATHER. HEART FAILURE CAUSE

Sad news was received here Tuesday, by Joseph, Emil and Theodore Nelson, announcing the death of their father, Tollef Nelson, who died at his home at Taylor, Wisconsin.

A letter received here last Saturday stated that all were well, and a telegram announcing his death came just three days later. His health had been very good for one of his age, he being 75 years of age.

Mr. Nelson was the father of 16 children, of whom nine sons and two daughters are still living, and also leaves an aged wife to mourn his loss.

Mr. Nelson was a veteran of the civil war. He was a man of fine character and highly respected by everyone who made his acquaintance, always speaking a kind word for all.

He located near Taylor 55 years ago, and has lived on the same land during all these years. He was one of the best known men in that part of Wisconsin, and was one of the oldest settlers. He was quite well known here, having visited his sons and families on several occasions, his last visit being a year ago last spring at which time he spent a month.

Emil and Joseph Nelson left Wednesday evening for Taylor to attend the funeral, which will be held Friday. The Gazette joins in extending sympathy to those who are left to mourn his loss.
