

## Obituary

Louis M. Crouse was born in Wisconsin September 25th, 1856. In her child hood she moved with her parents to Iowa, where she was married December 23, 1878, at Portland to Chas. W. Sidnam. She died in St. Paul, Minn., June 4th, 1912. Early in her married life she went with her husband to South Dakota. From there she moved to Dassel, Minn., where she spent a number of years, making valued friends. The last few years of her life were spent in North Dakota, where her husband died May 15, 1911, at their home in Spiritwood.
