A telegram was received here the latter part of last week, by C. E. Thayer, conveying the sad news of the death of his uncle, Walter Thayer of Salt Lake City. Mr. Thayer had several days previous been called to his home in Kilbourn, Wis., by the serious illness of his brother, so remained over for his uncle's funeral which took place in Kilbourn on Wednesday, his remains having been taken east by his daughter, Pearl. Mr. Thayer was, about fourteen years ago, agent for the Rogers Lumber Co. at Courtenay, and was well and favorably known in this vicinity. The cause of his death is not known, but at Christmas time he was suffering with blood poison of the jaw, caused from his teeth he having had some dental work done previously to this attack.
