

RE-OPENS WALKER HOTEL.

George Adams, who for several years has conducted a restaurant and lunch room in the Clark building, has re-opened the Walker Hotel and served the first meal the same evening the management of the Clark Hotel opened up their restaurant. The hotel property, for years owned by the late Robert Walker, was sold some time ago to H. Smith of Buchanan. The rooms have been cleaned, floors scrubbed and the dining room, office and kitchen rooms renovated and cleaned and the whole gives now a clean and orderly appearance.
