Barney Berlin, that well known old timer, who lives northeast of here, was in town Saturday renewing old acquaintances. He left that evening for Lethbridge, Canada, where he is helping to break some of the Canadian land with his big engine. He went to Canada last year and found conditions so encouraging that he purchased an engine and started in breaking for farmers, and he says that he did \$11,363 work of breaking during the season, getting \$1 per acre for breaking and \$3 for plowing stubble. He has been spending the winter at Wimbledon, and has rented his fine farm to his son-in-law, Rev.
