

The attendance record made by the Courtenay High School is something worthy of note. Out of a total enrollment of thirty-two there has been an average attendance of twenty-eight for each day school has been in session. Of the thirty-two, three have attended only about fifty days each. Leaving out those students who were non-numbers—(those who were out more than five days at a time)—the percentage of attendance is nearly ninety-seven. Furthermore, three boys, Clarence Fosholdt, Holmer Peterson, and Merritt Hoffman are credited with perfect attendance and Jennie Turner missed but a half day. There were several others who missed but a single day. Clarence Fosholdt has a still better record for he has not missed a day during his four years in High School, and so far has failed in only one subject in the state examinations.
