

## Auto Accident

There was a serious automobile wreck Friday afternoon near Spiritwood when the car, driven by R. E. Dresser, struck a dog and turned turtle several times.

Mr. Dresser's left hand and arm were badly skinned and bruised.

William Price suffered one broken rib and other injuries.

Charles Mahoney was struck across the chest by the car and quite seriously injured, besides being severely bruised and shaken up.

The men were returning from the Hopkins auction sale and it is said they were running at a very high rate of speed. Just as the machine topped a slight elevation a dog came out from the tall grass and got in front of the machine. The auto struck and killed the dog and then suddenly swerved to one side, went down the embankment and into the ditch, turning over several times, and throwing out the occupants violently. Three of the four wheels were broken off, the wind shield broken and the car badly injured. That some of the men were not instantly killed is accounted a miracle.

The car was a Buick, new this season, and the repair bill is expected to be very heavy. —**James-town Capital.**
