His aim was poor, and Mr. Neinfeldt considers it a very fortunate thing that such was the case. He was brought to town and given a hearing before Justice Bouer, who decided that the best thing to do with him would be to bound him over to district court. Pat Clark took him to Jamestown for safe keeping until the district court convenes next June.
