Fargo papers contain sensational stories regarding the mysterious disappearance of little Harry Parker, four year old son of Mrs. M. E. Cole of that city. The boy's father, A. O. Parker, formerly of Jamestown, from whom Mrs. Cole obtained a divorce about two years ago, is wanted in connection with the mystery. A. O. Parker, for some time a barber at Jamestown and player in the local orchestra, left this city suddenly about two weeks ago, saying he was "pulling out for Canada." Little Harry Parker disappeared from Fargo shortly afterwards, and it was at first supposed the lad had been drowned in the Red river. It is reported the body of the child was found in the Red river Wednesday.
