The cause of the fire is unknown. Mr. Spisla was away from town and knew nothing about it until his return. said that both the house and fur-BL niture was insured. The family had just retired for the night, L shortly after which one of the U members of the family smelled B t smoke, and in a few seconds the O entire building was ablaze and the family had just time enough D t to zet clear of the burning strucr n ture. f CNF Mr. Spisla has not decided just 1 what he will do about rebuilding.
