

## A New Townsite

Attorney Buck of Jamestown, has filed a plat of the townsite of Sydney, on the new Midland railroad. The new townsite is located on the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 33, township 138, range 64, about five miles from the townsite of Millarton. Jamestown parties will soon erect an elevator at the new townsite.

It is reported that there will be another station between Jamestown and Sydney. Sydney is about thirteen miles southwest of Jamestown. This other station may be known as Jamestown Junction, and will be near the James river at some point not yet announced. It is also stated that the Midland railroad will not attempt to run north from Jamestown by crossing the Northern Pacific tracks, but will take a course northeast and get out of the James river valley along what is known as the Seven Mile coulee, running northeastward through Stutsman county to Wimbledon, and from thence continuing north to the Canadian boundary. It is said that part of the right of way for the line north of the N.P. track has been secured by the Midland company.
