Met With Painful Accident

ONE OF OUR WELL KNOWN FARM-ERS INJURED BY BEING THROWN FROM BUGGY

Thursday about 11:30 a.m., Ben Thorsgaard, our well known farmer living north of here, met with a very painful accident, and at first it was thought to be serious.

As near as we can learn, Ben accompanied by his hired man, I had started for this city and I were opposite the old Milne farm, about three miles north of here, his team took fright at a road grader, and in trying to make a turn upset the rig, throwing the occupants to the ground. The other man was unhurt.

Thorvid Thorsgaard, a brother of Ben, happened to be about a quarter of a mile from the accident, and recognized the team when it darted pass him on a mad rush for town. He hurried on and found his brother on the ground unconscious. He put him in his wagon and hurried to town where Drs. Rasmusson and Shepherd attended him.

He was found to have two bad cuts on his head, which took several stitches, but no bones were found broken. The doctors state that while his injury is painful, nothing serious is expected as a result of the injury.
