Well Known Pionee Succumbs To Shock

Sanborn Enterprise: The painful news was announced Friday morning that Hon. Elmer E. Elliott had passed away at 9 p. m. Thursday. The funeral was held from the Congregational church on Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Deceased was the last surviving member of the Constitutional Convention, from Barnes county, Hon. John W. Scott and Jay Wellwood, the other two members, having preceded him to the Great Beyond. He was also a member of the Barnes County Drainage Board, and had over-taxed his endurance by a drive of more than 70 miles the day previous to receiving the news of his son's death, was one reason that reduced his powers to withstand the shock.

Mr. Elliott was one of Sanborn's olidest business men. He was born in Glencoe, Minn., Dec. 25, 1861.
