

Nagel Committed Suicide

Hope Pioneer: With the finding at sundown Sunday of the dead body of John Nagel, 30, with a bullet through his heart, a week's search for the would-be murderer of Mr. and Mrs. Martin Hendrickson, ended.

A son of H. C. Wang, a farmer, driving cows home, saw a black coat near a strawpile, and in reaching for it discovered the lifeless body of Nagel.

The revolver, with one chamber empty, was found beside the body, which was lying a distance of about one mile from the scene of the Saturday night shooting. The gun is believed by authorities to have been the same one which Nagel used in the attempt to take the lives of Mr. and Mrs. Hendrickson.

Sheriff Albert Sparrow was notified of the discovery of the body. With other county authorities he ordered it taken to Finley. Efforts will be made to locate relatives of the dead man. It is believed that Nagel ended his life shortly after the shooting at the Hendrickson home.
