
Body Recovered

The body of Nels Nelson, of Luv-erne, was recovered from the She-yenne River on Saturday, July 22, and was in an advanced state of de-composition as a result of lying for about eight days in the water, or ever since Mr. Nelson's disappear-ance on the afternoon of Friday, July 14th.

The theory is that Mr. Nelson had wandered about in the heat the Fri-day afternoon he disappeared, and had been affected by sun-stroke to such an extent as to render him mentally unbalanced, and had final-ly wandered into the river and drowned.

His watch, which remained in his pocket, had stopped about ten or eleven hours after his disappearance which would indicate that he had wandered about for some hours be-fore reaching the river. His money was also found intact in his pocket, which shows that robbery had not been the cause of his death.

The funeral was held Sunday.
