Body Recovered

The pody of Nels Nelson, of Luverne, was recovered from the Sheyenne River on Saturday, July 22, and was in an advanced state of decomposition as a result of lying for about eight days in the water, or ever since Mr. Nelson's disappearance on the afternoon of Friday, July 14th.

The theory is that Mr. Nelson had wandered about in the heat the Friday afternoon he disappeared, and had been affected by sun-stroke to such an extent as to render him mentally unbalanced, and had finally wandered into the river and drowned.

His watch, which remained in his pocket, had stopped about ten or eleven hours after his disappearance which would indicate that he had wandered about for some hours before reaching the river. His money was also found intact in his pocket, which shows that robbery had not been the cause of his death.

The funeral was held Sunday.
