Isreal Potvin died at a Fargo hospital on Monday, May 2nd. About three weeks ago an abcess broke out on his cheek; this growth became worse as time passed and it became necessary for him to go to the hospital, but blood-poisoning set in and he died soon after reaching the hospital.

Isreal Potvin was born at Maple Plain, Minn., in 1869, where he grew to manhood. In the year 1897 he married Jennie Farron, and to this union there were seven sons and three daughters born, all of whom are now living except one girl. Mr. Potvin came to this vicinity in the fall of 1917, and has been engaged in farming east of Hannaford since that time.
