

Lars Skjelset

Lars Skjelset was born at Jaderen, Norway, on September 13th, 1860, and was married in 1882. In May, 1893, Mr. and Mrs. Skjelset came to this country and located in Minnesota. Two years later they came to Griggs county and took up their residence on the farm about five miles northeast of Hannaford, where they resided until in November two years ago when they removed to Fargo on account of Mr. Skjelset's falling health.

Deceased had been gradually getting weaker and weaker, suffering from anemia, and finally succumbed to the disease on Saturday, September 10th. The remains were interred in Riverside cemetery, Monday, September 12th, in the presence of near relatives, and a number of neighbors and friends from here who went down to Fargo to attend the funeral.

Deceased leaves to mourn his death his sorrowing wife and eight children; four girls and four boys; L. O. Skjelset, of Revere, Arne, on the farm near Hannaford; Laurits, of Buffalo Springs, N.D.; and Ragna, Gudrun, Sigurd, Huldah and Esther of Fargo.
