# H. C. Storey

Last week we briefly mentioned in these columns the death of H. C. Storey, of Wimbledon, district manager of the A. O. U. W. lodge. The following is taken from the Wimbledon News:

"Following an operation for appendicitis Harvey C. Storey passed away at St. John's hospital in Fargo Feb. 27 at the age of 38 years. The news of Mr. Storey's death came as a great shock to the entire community. In the prime of life and active in his work up to the time he went to Fargo the Sunday before, it seemed hard to realize that he had passed away.

"Mr. Storey first suffered an attack of appendicitis about a year and a half ago. Last winter he was sick with influenza when another attack of appendicitis developed. While he fairly well recovered physicians advised him that an operation would be necessary to prevent further attacks. Accordingly he entered the hospital in Fargo where he underwent an operation Saturday morning. It was found that he had a bad case of appendicitis and while the operation was in a measure successful he suffered a relapse and died at 12:20 o'clock Sunday noon. Mrs. Storey was at the hospital during the operation and with him during his last hours."
