

Peter Falstad, of the A. F. C. garage of this village, was one of the contestants in the ski tournament held near Moorhead last Sunday afternoon. There were about forty skiers entered in the contest, and a large crowd had gathered to see the tournament. The winner of first place was Arthur Romstad, of Fergus Falls, Minn., who succeeded in making two nearly perfect jumps of 84 feet each and then made a leap of 86 feet without falling. Knut Garsteig, of Concordia College, was second. A veteran skier, O. Håga, of Reynolds, N. D., 60 years of age, was a contestant; he won seventh place. Mr. Falstad was placed sixth.
