Two lives were lost when Fast Mail train No. 27 plunged through the bridge over Miller river, near Skykomish, Wash., Sunday morning, Dec. 11th, Fireman Irvin and Mail Clerk Hileman, both of Seattle, being the victims. The scene of the wreck, the Miller River Bridge, had been under observation of the road officials, for it is reported that the county road bridge just above the railroad bridge had gone out some time earlier and the wooden structure had lodged against a pier of the railroad bridge. No. 27 approached the bridge at high speed and the engine sped out over the approach, left the track as it came to the main span and plunged through and over the left side of the bridge. Two refrigerator cars shot on across the bridge, one landing on the west bank of the river and the other coming to a stop just at the westerly part of the bridge, which broke in two in the center and fell into the water, the car sticking up into the overhead frame. All the other cars, excepting the last one in the train, went into the river.
