The Hannaford school opened last Tuesday with an enrollment of about 140. Of that number about 20 are in the high school, 35 in the grammar department, 50 in the intermediate and 35 in the primary department. This is a somewhat larger enrollment than the Hannaford school has had in former years and it is found that the present number of teachers will be unable to do the work as it should be done wherefore the board has decided to hire another teacher who will then have charge of the fifth and sixth grades. To date no one has been hired, but it is hoped that one may be obtained some time this week.
