George J. Jacobson, formerly president of the defunct Farmers State Bank at Walum, who was convicted of embesslement and sentene d by Judge Englert to five years in the state penitentiary, was taken from Valley City to Bismarck last Tuesday under the escort of the tate transportation officer, to begin serving his term. Mr. Jacobson was unable to secure bonds so as to be able to remain a liberty while his case was being appealed.
