Binford people were shocked Saturday morning to learn of the neardeath of J. D. Reid, from poisoning. Mr. Reid had been in Al health the previous evening and through the night. Early Saturday morning he trose to take a dose of medicine and by mistake secured a small bottle of thloroform and drank the entire contents, less than two ounces. He was tiezed with such severe pain that it was impossible for him to make an outery, but by knocking on the floor the attention of Mrs. Lydia Boeckman was attracted, who called Dr. Trascott. The doctor administered all possible aid and then called Dr. Brimi, of Cooperstown in consulta-For a few days his life was hanging in the balance but has since rallied to that at present he is able to sit up and take nourishment. The chloroform had been used for cleanpurposes and had been in the house for months.
