Marcus Thoreson and Harold drove up from Fargo last week, and Marcus is looking after business interests in this village. Mr. Thoreson recently returned from a 2600mile trip to Montana, visiting all the recently opened off fields in that state. There are wells producing up to 300 barrels of high quality oil a day, and at present there are perhaps 75 wells in process of drilling. None of the wells so far brought in ire gushers. but the bil has to be pumped out. Geologists who have made a thorough study of the Mont- r tas fields are of the opinion that as jet the real oil pool in that state has tot been discovered, and that the pospects are that Montana will become one of the biggest oil producok states ever known. Marcus aleady owned some land in the prosoctive oil country and while on this the secured options on still more; substantial evidence that he with in the still further development of the oil industry in our neighborbg state
