

DORIS BERG'S FUNERAL

Former Hannaford Girl Laid to Rest in Fairview Ceme- tery at Stanley

The following account of Doris Berg's funeral is taken from the Stanley Sun of October 21:

The funeral of Doris Berg was held in Stanley at the Presbyterian church last Sunday afternoon at three o'clock. Rev. O. T. Nelson of the Lutheran church preached the funeral sermon. The body was laid to rest in Fairview cemetery.

The deceased was the youngest child and the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Berg of Lostwood. At the time of her death she was 17 years, 11 months and 20 days old. She leaves her parents and two brothers. She had been suffering for many years with Bright's Disease which finally caused her death.
