

William Blake Is Killed By Train

William Blake, state humane officer, was instantly killed at the Grace City crossing of the Great Northern railway when the engine of his automobile died and the north bound train crashed into the car that was stalled on the track.

The accident occurred about 11:45 this morning. The engineer of the train was unable to stop the train as the automobile stopped suddenly on the track only a short distance ahead.

An inquest will be held at Grace City. William Blake is well known throughout the state, and has been a visitor in Hannaford on several occasions.
