

Sjur J. Erdahl died at the home of Sam Holme in the township of Dover, on Thursday, Feb. 15. He had been weak and ailing for some time but death came unexpectedly. Deceased was born at Erdahl, Eldfjord, Bergen, Norway, seventy-three years ago, and at the age of sixteen years enlisted in the regular army and for thirty-five years served his country and his king, advancing to the rank of commanding seargent. In 1900 he came to the home of a brother in Minnesota and later stopped for a time with Rev. Anderson at Ft. Ransom, N. D. Deceased is survived by a wife and children who live at Voss, Norway, a son who is somewhere on the Pacific coast, and a daughter, Mrs. Lina Berdahl of Minneapolis. The funeral was conducted from the home of John L. Miklethun by Rev. P. A. Thoreson, Tuesday, Feb. 20, and interment was made in Eldfjord cemetery.
