Miss Clara Greenland, of Coopers-town, died Monday evening, Sept. 27. Deceased was born at Lanesboro, Minn., in 1877. Four years later her parents, Mr. and Mrs. F. Greenland, came to Griggs county, taking up a homestead in Bald Hill township. For many years past, the family home has been at Coopers-town.

Miss Greenland taught in the public schools of this county for nine years. Then for five years she served as assistant county superintendent of schools, from which position she resigned three years ago on account of failing health.

Deceased was an active member of the Lutheran congregation and she was a leader in all church work. Her departure is a sad loss not only to the family circle, but to a very wide circle of devoted friends.

The funeral took place from the Lutheran church at Cooperstown, Thursday, Rev. Sweger officiating. Interrment took place in the Cooperstown cemetery.
