

Valley City Courier: William Hadlock, a former citizen of Griggs county, and some years ago a member of the Griggs county board of county commissioners, died very suddenly at Joplin, Mont., last Friday. The deceased was walking across the street and at once pitched forward and died from heart failure. He was unmarried and was engaged at farming.
