When Mr. Henning arose and went to turn on the draft in the base burner he found the fire was out, and thinking to make quick work starting it he took the gasoline can and poured a quantity on the coal. Knowing it was gasoline his wife cautioned him to not use it, but he applied a match to the coal, and in an instant there was a terrific explosion which filled house with flames The wife, who was in bed in an adjoining room, seized her baby and attempted to dash through the blazing room to the door, but their clothing was almost entirely burned from their hodies, and the burns and the exposure after they were outside proved fatal in a short time. The man was badly burned also but as he was dressed his clothing afforded some protection, and he is now on the road to recovery. As soon as the accident happened Dr. Lewis was telephoned for and he went there as quickly as possible to do all in his power to relieve the suffering of the victims. Henning had the gasoline can in his hand when he applied the match and it was blown through the window of the house, also through the window of Carl McDanjel's house a few feet away.
