

Miss Laura Johnson, who was employed by the Lund Investment Co. of Valley City, formerly of Coopers-town, lost her life last Wednesday evening when the automobile she was driving went over a big embankment. The accident occurred about ten miles east of Hannaford near the Geo. Slingsby farm. It is not known exactly just what time or how the sad accident happened, but it is thought that she met her death between 9 o'clock in the evening and 7 o'clock in the morning. She was found early Thursday morning, pinned under the heavy car. From all appearances death must have been instantaneous. The road at this place was not in such a bad condition but there were a few bad ruts at the place where the car went over. There were three bad ruts at that place and she evidently got the wheels in one of these ruts and tried to turn out when the big car got too near the embankment and turned over. The states attorney, coroner and Mr. Lund went out to the scene of the accident Thursday morning.
