

A telegram was received here Sunday evening by Louis Alm, stating that S. S. Ostebo had died in Minneapolis that day in a place on Washington Avenue. At the time of going to press we are unable to secure further details. Sjurson, is the name he was best known by here. He has been a resident of Hannaford for many years, working part of the time as bookkeeper at the Hannaford Hotel and part of the time at his trade as painter. He had a quarter-section of land in South Dakota. He had no near relatives in this country as far as known, and it is probable that the remains will be interred in Minneapolis.
