

Word was received here Wednesday by relatives, Cora Lykken and Mrs. R. E. Leiser, that their cousin, Mrs. O. W. Sundahl of Winnepeg, had passed away on Wednesday morning at five o'clock. Mrs. Sundahl was burned to death in an explosion of gasoline which occurred late Tuesday afternoon in the apartment in which she resided with her husband. A tin of gasoline with which she was cleaning a dress became ignited it appears, setting fire to the furniture of the room.
