

Kidnapper Chased Across the State

Wolf Point Herald: The principal in the kidnapping case, that originated here July 21, at latest reports was still at large some place in central Montana.

Albert M. Saby is the man wanted and Clara L. Anderson is the girl he is charged with spiriting away. Accompanied by her grandfather, the girl, who is said to be less than fifteen years of age, was at the Wolf Point depot to take No. 3 for her home at Hannaford, N. D., after a visit with relatives on the south side.

Saby suddenly appeared on the scene and was observed to engage the girl in conversation. She acted as if she wanted nothing to do with him but just as the train pulled in he got her into an automobile he had waiting and that is the last seen of either of them.

The trail was picked up at Glasgow where the car was abandoned.

They were again heard of at Chinook where he is reported to have again started overland by team with the girl. Helge W. Hauge, a relative of the girl, went west in pursuit and last week Deputy Patten went west accompanied by another interested party, but returned without finding the parties sought.

The past history of the case is not well known, but it is said that Saby is a cousin of the girl and has tried to force his attentions upon her where they both resided in North Dakota. Miss Anderson is said to have never encouraged Saby, who is a man of mature years, but to have repulsed him emphatically.

Since the above was written the girl in the case has been brought home, but Saby is still at large.
