

In connection with the alleged attempt at murder, an account of which is printed on the first page of this issue, a warrant has been issued charging John Griesinger, with assault and battery, and he has been arrested as a suspect in the case of the attempt to take the life of Freeman Curtis. Griesinger, a farmer about fifty-seven years of age, residing near Karnak, has been arrested and after a preliminary hearing was put under \$500 bail bonds. The arrest of Griesinger was made on circumstantial evidence, the only clue the authorities have is a hat found in the house and which is thought to belong to Griesinger.
