

Grand Forks Herald: The man who wrote that the "little Ford rambles right along," never tried to go through snow drifts with it, declares Edgar Olson, field agent for the Grand Forks County Better Farming association. At 12:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon, he started from Grand Forks in his Ford car with J. D. Deets of the Union Stock yards, for central school house in Bentru township. There was a farmers' club meeting in progress, and Deets was to deliver the address. Messrs. Olson and Deets returned to the city at 6:30 o'clock without delivering an address—except to each other. It seems that they got along nicely until they reached a particularly difficult snow drift about 12 miles from town. The Ford rammed into it, but didn't come out. They "got out" but couldn't "get under." Neither could they get through, and for awhile they thought they wouldn't get back. There was no Oscar II cruising in the vicinity and consequently the warlike operations went on uninterrupted. They didn't melt the snow, but they would have put a whole navy of peace expeditions to flight.
