The quarterly justice report, of Wm. Angus was on motion approved.

Bids for coal were received as follows:

- Blackwell Bros.:
 - 40 tons anthracite stove, @ \$11.75 per ton.
 - 20 tons Hocking Valley, @ \$11.00 per ton.

Bid was for coal delivered at courthouse; anthracite to be delivered during August; Hocking Valley as needed but all before Dec. 1 Crane-Johnson Co.:

- 40 tons anthracite, nut, stove or egg, @ \$12.00 per ton.
- 20 tons screened lump soft coal, @ 10.25 per ton.

Bid for coal delivered at courthouse; immediate acceptance; delivery of entire order to be made from the car as soon as possible to get the coal here.

Action on coal bids was on motion postponed until the next meeting.

The petition from Dover township for \$300.00 for building culverts was considered and on motion allowed in the sum of \$300.00, to be paid on approval of the board.

Moved that \$1500.00 be paid T. M. Swingen, advance on bridge under construction at Hannaford. Seconded and carried.

Board on motion adjourned to meet Aug. 14, 1917, at 9 a. m.
