

## Edgar Leaving for Madison

The Grand Forks Herald published the following article after Edgar Gustafson had left their employ to go to the University of Wisconsin:

Edgar H. Gustafson, who has been on the repertorial staff of The Herald during the summer, has resigned his position. He will leave shortly for Madison, Wis., where he will do graduate work in economics at the University of Wisconsin. Mr. Gustafson was awarded a fellowship in economics by the Wisconsin institution.

Mr. Gustafson was graduated from the North Dakota university in June, 1915, with a B. A. degree. In June, 1916, he was graduated with a master's degree. While at the university, Mr. Gustafson took a prominent and constructive part in debating and oratory and other activities. He represented the university on two debating teams—those which met Manitoba university and Fargo college. He also was active in athletics and got a letter for track work.
