

Last Tuesday night the electric light plant was completed and started to operate. Street lights have been placed thruout the business and residence districts of the village and electric lights have been installed in nearly all business places and most residences. This is a great improvement to our village. Especially are the four street lights to a block a great improvement over the few old gasoline lamps we used to see occasionally before. At present the plant is run during the night-time only but we hope it will be arranged so we can also have day-service. Power is furnished by a 25 horse-power Fairbanks Morse kerosene engine.
