

MYERS' TRIAL MAY 22

Geo. C. Meyers, held in the county jail on the charge of killing Ed. Lundmark at Sutton Monday morning, April 17, was given a hearing before Magistrate Rearick Saturday afternoon, waived examination and was bound over to appear before the district court, which convenes in Coopersiown May 22, with judge Coffey on the bench.

Meyers has been ill at his cell in the county jail the past few days, but at present is in better spirits. Upon the advice of his attorney, Harry Lashkowitz, of Fargo, he is not making any statements regarding the crime. Upon first being committed to jail Meyers was inclined to considerable talking.

States Attorney Tufte is building up a strong case against the accused man, and looks for a speedy conviction when the case is tried next month.
