The George Rasmussen Barn Burns Dazey Commercial: The new barn on the George N. Rasmussen farm which was reconstructed last summer after it had suffered from the effects of the severe storm that visited this section of the country last spring, was totally destroyed by fire on Monday forenoon. The flames were first discovered about 10:30 Monday morning, Mr. Rasmussen being the first to make the discovery. He noticed smoke issuing from the barn and when he went to see what the cause of it was he found the entire inside of the barn in flames. The fire gained such headway that it was impossible to save the structure. The fire was soon discovered by people living in town and the fire department got busy and took the chemicals to the scene and they were utilized in saving the nearby buildings. One horse which was in the barn was burned to death, it being impossible to get the animal out. All other stock was saved, most of it being out of the barn at the time of the fire. The building was partly covered by insurance but the loss will be a great amount in addition to the insurance received. The barn was one of the largest and best constructed buildings to be found in the section of the country.
