Westerhouser, residing 34 miles north of Sutton, took three-grain biehloride tablets Sunday morning, mistaking them for other medicine, and as a result is in a serious condition. Dr. Lewis of Sutton was called to attend the case, and he in turn called Dr. Brimi of this city in consultation. All that could be done was done for the sufferer, but as bichloride is a very slow acting poison, it will be a week or ten days before it can be definitely stated whether or not the victim will recover. This should be a warning to others not to take headache tablets and the like before making sure they are taking some deadly poison.
