

As stated in our last issue Endre Arestad had died at his home in Ball Hill township, Friday morning, Feb. 22. Deceased was born, in Rhime, Norway, 71 years, 7 months, and 28 days from the time of his death, and had resided on a homestead in Griggs county since 1883, thus making him one of the pioneers of this part of the state.
