

Beautiful and impressive Memorial Services in honor of the memory of Mervin J. Armstrong were held last Sunday afternoon in the Hall, which had been appropriately decorated for the occasion. The Hall was filled to capacity by people who had come from far and near to do honor to the memory of this young man who sacrificed his life on the battlefields of France. Rev. J. C. Wilson had charge of the program, there was scripture reading by Rev. P. A. Thoreson, songs by the choir and by the audience, and the Memorial Address was given by Dr. Roe of Jamestown College whose theme was "Sacrifice." A golden star was added to the service flag for Hannaford and community, and this star was placed in the third position, for as far as can be ascertained Mervin Armstrong was the third boy from this vicinity to volunteer for service in the forces of the United States.
