

Obituary

C. L. Berg was born in Trondhjem Norway, in 1841. He came to America in 1874 and to Fargo in 1878. He resided in Fargo, where he conducted an employment agency, until 1903, when he moved to this village where he lived until just before his death. He suffered two paralytic strokes a few weeks ago, but apparently was recovering, and it was possible to take him to Fargo to a hospital for treatment, but last Tuesday morning he suffered another stroke and passed away.

Deceased is survived by the widow, and two daughters, Mrs. Walter Probstfield, of Moorhead, Minn., and Miss Cora Berg, assistant cashier of the First National Bank of McVille, N. D.

Funeral services were held Friday, November 28, at the Probstfield home in Moorhead, Rev. Stickney of Fargo speaking in English, and Rev. Thoreson in Norwegian. The remains were laid to rest in Riverside cemetery in Moorhead. The pall bearers were old friends and acquaintances of the deceased. Rev. Thoreson was the only one from Hannaford who was present at the ceremony, and he brought with him flowers and greetings from the many friends of Mr. Berg in this village.
