Mrs. Grace Christianson was born in Mabel township thirty-one years ago. She was the oldest daughter of Charles Frydenberg and wife, Anna Lee Frydenberg. In 1910 she was married to John Christianson, who some years earlier had emigrated from Vestre Gausdal, Guldbrandsdalen, Norway. To them were born six children, all boys.
